**Service to the Church:** Altar serving is a way to contribute and serve the Church. By assisting the priest and helping to create a reverent atmosphere during worship, you are supporting the religious community and participating in the important work of the Church.



**Learning and Formation:** Altar serving provides an opportunity for personal growth and learning. You can develop a deeper understanding of the liturgy, the prayers, and the symbols used during the Mass.
